

About the program:

The Axiom Quartet's program "Moments of Truth" is no different: the group wants for you to feel the different shades and facets of truth in human heart regardless of when the music was written. You will hear pieces as diverse as Electronic Dance Music "Insight" by Haywyre, J.S.Bach's stunning aria "Erbarme Dich," a Fleetwood Mac super hit from the 80s "Little Lies," a gorgeous aria from Claudio Monteverdi opera from 1600s, and a Billie Holiday song "Don't Explain." Each of these pieces describes a specific take on truth, be it the exhilaration of knowing one's insight, begging for forgiveness, flat out lying or the subtlety of truth in love.

But that's not all! The Axiom Quartet's program also includes music by Charles Ives and an original composition by Karl Blench titled "Axiom," in which the quest for truth and reason ends in the realization it's been there from the very beginning.
