performed in the **Throne Room**. This beautiful room, with its high domed ceiling and nature's décor, provides a stunning backdrop for the concert. The acoustics are great, making it **a memorable experience for** both performers and guests.

Concerts have access only to the Throne Room. To **tour the cave**, reserve a space by calling 830.537.4212 or emailing <u>cwan@cavewithoutaname.com</u> with your date, time (based on the top of the hour), and the number in your party. From Memorial Day to Labor Day, the first tour is at 9 a.m., the last at 5 p.m. For the rest of the year, the first tour is at 10 a.m., the last at 4 p.m. Plan to arrive 15 minutes early to purchase your tickets. The tour last about an hour.

**Concert ticketing is final.** Once purchased, tickets cannot be refunded or exchanged. We appreciate your understanding and look forward to your visit.

**Tickets:** You will receive physical tickets once you arrive at the concert. When you arrive at the cave, visit the gift shop for your entry tickets. Your name and ticket information are on our special guest list.

After your tickets are purchased, a confirmation email is sent from <u>cavewithoutaname@att.net</u>.

Concerts are open **seating** and chairs are in the cave. To protect the fragile cave environment, only **bottled water** is allowed in the cave. You can bring your own or purchase a bottle from the gift shop.

**Entry/Exit** to the cave is via 126 steps with handrails and eight landings. Guests are encouraged to take the steps at their own pace. There is no wheelchair access to the cave.

All **restrooms** are at ground level.

**Duration** – most concerts last about 90 minutes.

**Dress comfortably**. The year-round temperature is 66 degrees with 100% humidity (it feels like 70-75 degrees). Wear comfortable walking shoes with good traction. High heels are discouraged.

**Rainy Weather** - Cave Without a Name is open year-round, rain or shine. Visitors may want an umbrella for the short walk to and from the cave entrances.

**Come early** and have a picnic on the grounds from the delights and, perhaps, a bottle of wine in your picnic basket. Spend time on the surface and enjoy the countryside and trails. If you are interested in *overnight tent camping or RV hookups*, call 830.537.4212.
